The Great CANOE Adventure, June 3th, 4th and 5th.

The Senior High Great Canoe Adventure is fast approaching. What better way to shove-off the start of a new and exciting summer than a float trip on the beautiful Little Niangua River in central Missouri. Located approximately two and one half-hours southeast of Kansas City, Mo.

WHO, WHAT, WHERE: The Conference of Restoration Elders / Youth Council is sponsoring a float trip on the Little Niangua River for Senior High Youth ages 15 to 18 years of age. From Kansas City take highway 291 to 50 to 65 to 7 to J-Rd. then turn left on Taylor.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE: Friday evening, June 3 (1) Leave for the Great Canoe Adventure from Waldo Restoration Branch in Independence at 6:00 p.m. Arrive at Little Niangua Campgrounds 8:30 p.m. **Saturday June 4** (1) Rise and shine; (2) 7 am breakfast; (3) Attack the river for a day-long float and adventure; (4) Sandwich smorgasbord & relaxing by the river side; (5) Dinner at 6:30 p.m. (6) Campfire and singing fellowship at 9:00 p.m.; (7) 11 p.m. lights out. **Sunday, June 5** (1) Rise and shine at 7 a.m. (2) Early morning worship 8:00 a.m. (3) Brunch after worship service. (4) 11:00 p.m. head for home. Arrive back at Waldo at 2:00pm.

TRANSPORTATION: Car-pooling or bus transportation costs are not included in the cost of the float trip. Ride should be arranged by branch youth leaders or call Scott Eastin for additional information about car-pooling.

LODGING: We will be camping at the Little Niangua Campground. These sites are shaded and are along the beautiful Little Niangua River. Campsite includes, hot showers, campfire area and volleyball/recreation area. **Campers must furnish All Sleeping Gear (Sleeping bag, blankets, pillows, rain gear, bug juice and Tents for camping.** If you have a tent or a extra tent we can use, please let Scott know so we can set up bedding arrangements for all the campers.

COST: The cost is \$40.00 for camping. These prices include two nights of camping/lodging, canoe rental, canoe insurance, and four meals. (Saturday breakfast, lunch, dinner and Sunday bunch). The total price is due two days before the trip. Cancellations seven days before the trip will forfeit half of the cost to cover canoe and campsite deposit. **Do not send cash in the mail.**
