These items will be posted at the registration table in the foyer. The schedule is also in Section 1 of your notebook and the floor plan is on the back cover of the notebook.

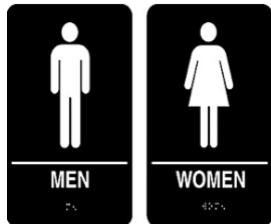
FREE WILL LUNCH: Free will lunches are offered this week at Outreach RB and Living Hope RB. The schedule and addresses are listed below:



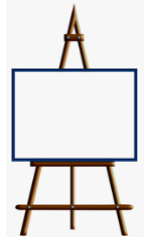
Monday and Tuesday: Outreach RB located at 723 S. Crysler Ave., Independence. (Only 0.06 miles from the Stone Church)

REFRESHMENTS: There will be refreshments, downstairs in the Luff Auditorium following the **Sunday and Friday** evening services **only**.

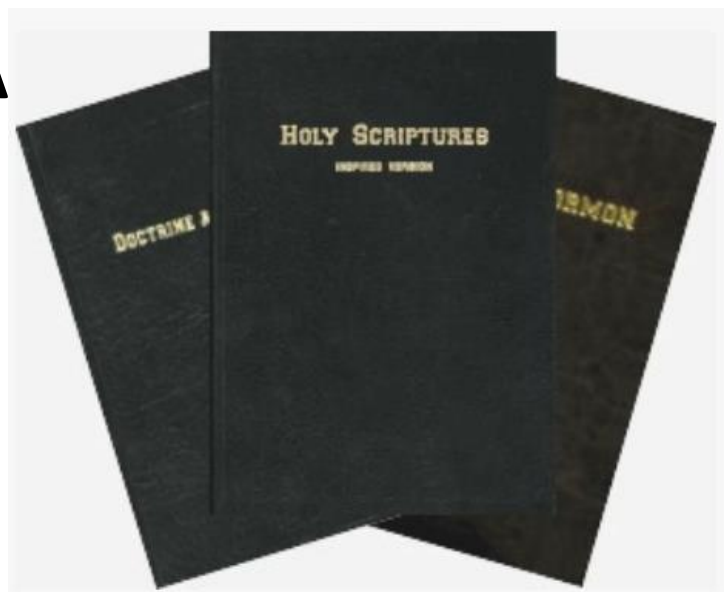
