Solemn Assembly Scripture References

<u>Leviticus 23:36</u> Seven days ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the Lord; on the eighth day shall be a holy convocation unto you, and ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the Lord; it is a **solemn assembly**; and ye shall do no servile work therein.

<u>Numbers 29:35</u> On the eighth day ye shall have a **solemn assembly**; ye shall do no servile work therein;

Deuteronomy 16:8 Six days thou shalt eat unleavened bread; and on the seventh day shall be a **solemn assembly** to the Lord thy God; thou shalt do no work therein.

2 Kings 10:20 And Jehu said, Proclaim a **solemn assembly** for Baal. And they proclaimed it.

2 Kings 23:Intro Josiah causeth the book of the law to be read in a **solemn assembly** -- He reneweth the covenant of the Lord -- He destroyeth idolatry -- He burnt dead men's bones upon the altar of Beth-el -- He kept passover -- He put away witches -- Josiah slain -- Jehoiakim made king.

<u>2 Chronicles 7:9</u> And in the eighth day they made a **solemn assembly**; for they kept the dedication of the altar seven days, and the feast seven days.

Nehemiah 8:18 Also day by day, from the first day unto the last day, he read in the book of the law of God. And they kept the feast seven days; and on the eighth day was a **solemn assembly**, according unto the manner.

<u>Joel 1:14</u> Sanctify ye a fast, call a **solemn assembly**, gather the elders and all the inhabitants of the land into the house of the Lord your God, and cry unto the Lord,

<u>Joel 2:15</u> Blow the trumpet in Zion, sanctify a fast, call a **solemn assembly**;

Zephaniah 3:18 I will gather them that are sorrowful for the **solemn assembly**, who are of thee, to whom the reproach of it was a burden.

<u>DC 85:19b</u> tarry ye, tarry ye in this place, and call a **solemn assembly**, even of those who are the first laborers in this last kingdom; and let those whom they have warned in their traveling, call on the Lord, and ponder the warning in their hearts which they have received, for a little season.

<u>DC 85:36a</u> Therefore, verily I say unto you, my friends, Call your **solemn assembly**, as I have commanded you; and as all have not faith, seek ye diligently and teach one another words of wisdom; yea, seek ye out of the best books words of wisdom; seek learning even by study, and also by faith.

<u>DC 92:1e</u> they who are not chosen have sinned a very grievous sin, in that they are walking in darkness at noonday; and for this cause, I gave unto you a commandment, that you should call your **solemn assembly**;

<u>DC 85 18a</u> And if your eye be single to my glory, your whole bodies shall be filled with light, and there shall be no darkness in you, and that body which is filled with light comprehendeth all things.

18b Therefore, sanctify yourselves that your minds become single to God, and the days will come that you shall see him: for he will unveil his face unto you, and it shall be in his own time, and in his own way, and according to his own will.

19a Remember the great and last promise which I have made unto you: cast away your idle thoughts and your excess of laughter far from you;

19b tarry ye, tarry ye in this place, and call a **solemn assembly**, even of those who are the first laborers in this last kingdom; and let those whom they have warned in their traveling, call on the Lord, and ponder the warning in their hearts which they have received, for a little season.

19c Behold, and lo, I will take care of your flocks and will raise up elders and send unto them.

20a Behold, I will hasten my work in its time; and I give unto you who are the first laborers in this last kingdom, a commandment, that you assemble yourselves together, and organize yourselves, and prepare yourselves; and sanctify yourselves;

20b yea, purify your hearts, and cleanse your hands and your feet before me, that I may make you clean;

20c that I may testify unto your Father, and your God, and my God, that you are clean from the blood of this wicked generation, that I may fulfill this promise, this great and last promise which I have made unto you, when I will.

21a Also, I give unto you a commandment that ye shall continue in prayer and fasting from this time forth.

<u>DC 36a</u> Therefore, verily I say unto you, my friends, Call your **solemn assembly**, as I have commanded you; and as all have not faith, seek ye diligently and teach one another words of wisdom; yea, seek ye out of the best books words of wisdom; seek learning even by study, and also by faith.

36b Organize yourselves; prepare every needful thing, and establish a house, even a house of prayer, a house of fasting, a house of faith, a house of learning, a house of glory, a house of order, a house of God;

36c that your incomings may be in the name of the Lord; that your outgoings may be in the name of the Lord; that all your salutations may be in the name of the Lord, with uplifted hands unto the Most High.

37a Therefore cease from all your light speeches, from all laughter, from all your lustful desires, from all your pride and light- mindedness, and from all your wicked doings.

37b Appoint among yourselves a teacher, and let not all be spokesmen at once, but let one speak at a time, and let all listen unto his sayings, that when all have spoken, that all may be edified of all, and that every man may have an equal privilege.

38a See that ye love one another; cease to be covetous; learn to impart one to another as the gospel requires; cease to be idle; cease to be unclean; cease to find fault one with another;
