

8c that they may bring forth fruit meet for their Father's kingdom; otherwise, there remaineth a scourge and a judgment to be poured out upon the children of Zion. . . .

A Letter Sent to Zion by Orson Hyde & Hyrum Smith

"Therefore, with the feelings of inexpressible anxiety for your welfare, we say again, repent, repent or Zion must suffer, for the scourge and judgment must come upon her. . . . Tell them to read the Book of Mormon and obey it; read the commandments that are printed and obey them. . . . Tell them that they must not have come up to Zion to sit down in idleness, neglecting the things of God but they are to be diligent and faithful in obeying the New Covenant.

"If the people do not repent the Lord would seek another place, and another people! Zion is the place where the temple will be built, and the people gathered. But all people upon that Holy Land and being under condemnation, the Lord will cut off, if they will repent not, and bring another race upon it, that will serve Him. The Lord will seek another place to prepare His word to go forth to the nations."

Given in 1834 = D&C Sec. 102:2c And Zion cannot be built up unless it is by the principles of the law of the celestial kingdom; otherwise, I cannot receive her unto myself; 2d and my people must needs be chastened until they learn obedience, if it must needs be by the things which they suffer.

D&C Sec. 102:3c Therefore, in consequence of the transgression of my people, it is expedient in me that mine elders should wait for a little season for the redemption of Zion, that they themselves may be prepared and that my people may be taught more perfectly, and have experience . . .




The Time of the Judges

 Judges 3:5 And the children of Israel dwelt among the Canaanites, Hittites, and Amorites....... 6 And they took their daughters to be their wives, and gave their daughters to their sons, and served their gods.



Judges 3:8 Therefore the anger of the Lord was hot against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of Chushan-rishathaim king of Mesopotamia; and the children of Israel served Chushan-rishathaim eight years.

9 And when the children of Israel cried unto the Lord, the Lord raised up a deliverer to the children of Israel, who delivered them, even Othniel the son of Kenaz, Caleb's younger brother.



The Canaanite's ruled the Plains and low hill regions through their advanced military power. They had mastered making metal. This would keep the Israelites (and other raiders) from settling permanently or from significantly disturbing Canaanite trade routes along Jezreel Valley. They held a force of 900 chariots. At that time, any opposing force lay at the mercy of this powerful Canaanite weapon. When confronting them in the open field nothing could stand against their Iron Chariots. They held a mighty weapon of destruction in their chariots, much like tanks today. What field army could stand against them?

1 Samuel 13:19-22 19 Now there was no smith found throughout all the land of Israel; for the Philistines said, Lest the Hebrews make them swords or spears. 20 But all the Israelites went down to the Philistines to sharpen, every man, his share, and his coulter, and his axe, and his mattock. 21 Yet they had a file for the mattocks, and for the coulters, and for the forks, and for the axes, and to sharpen the goads. 22 So it came to pass in the day of battle that there was neither sword nor spear found in the hand of any of the people that were with Saul and Jonathan;

Fear Ruled Their Minds

Judges 4:1-3 1 And the children of Israel again did evil in the sight of the Lord when Ehud was dead. 2 And the Lord sold them into the hand of Jabin, king of Canaan, that reigned in Hazor, the captain of whose host was Sisera, which dwelt in Harosheth of the Gentiles. 3 And the children of Israel cried unto the Lord; for he had nine hundred chariots of iron; and twenty years he mightily oppressed the children of Israel.

Note: The men of that day were filled with fear of Jabin and his commander Sisera. They had been under their hand for 20 years. They feared the Chariots!

Bill Jones Quote:

"What is the Spirit of Fear? Fear itself is a natural human emotion triggered by perceived danger.

"The 'Spirit of Fear' is often described as a Spiritual Influence, produced from an outside negative force which instills anxiety or increasing uncertainty or lack of confidence.

"Its presence can be quite debilitating. It can lead to excessive worry, anxiety, lack of trust in God or one's own self.

"It can prevent people from taking action or pursing goals. <u>It can be a state of mind that hinders faith.</u>"

Israel Went Up to Mount Tabor

Judges 4:13-14 13 And Sisera gathered together all his chariots, even nine hundred chariots of iron, and all the people that were with him, from Harosheth of the Gentiles unto the river of Kishon. 14 And Deborah said unto Barak, Up; for this is the day in which the Lord hath delivered Sisera into thine hand. Is not the Lord gone out before thee? So, Barak, went down from mount Tabor, and ten thousand men after him.

Sisera is Killed

Judges 4:17-21

- 17 Howbeit Sisera fled away on his feet to the tent of Jael, the wife of Heber, the Kenite; for there was peace between Jabin, the king of Hazor, and the house of Heber, the Kenite.
- 18 And Jael went out to meet Sisera and said unto him, Turn in, my lord, turn in to me; fear not. And when he had turned in unto her into the tent, she covered him with a mantle.

The Kenite people were nomadic people. Lived in tents, often close to the children of Israel. They were the people of Jethro, Moses's father-in-law. Their stories often intertwined with Israel.

Samuel spoke of them:
1 Samuel 15:6 for ye

showed kindness to all the children of Israel when they came up out of Egypt.

Judges 5:24

Blessed above women shall Jael, the wife of Heber, the Kenite, be; blessed shall she be above women in the tent.



Deborah a Judge

From Different Bible Commentaries

Deborah was one of the rulers of the Hebrews (and the only female leader) in the Old Testament. These rulers were called "mishpat," which is translated as "judges." A role that originated back when Moses appointed helpers to assist him in resolving arguments among the people. (Exodus 18).

As a judge, she resolved disputes and governed with wisdom that earned her the respect of an entire nation. Think about it – in a culture where women rarely held public roles, people from all walks of life climbed the hills to her palm tree seeking her counsel.

This wasn't just because of her titles; it was because she demonstrated a rare combination of divine wisdom, practical judgment, and compassionate leadership.

This is speaking of Christ but we can learn from this about "Gifts of Wisdom and Understanding working in His servants lives also"

<u>Isaiah 11:1</u> And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots;

And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon him, 1. the Spirit of wisdom and

- 2. understanding = Work together = Holy Spirit enlightens & expands our minds to comprehend
- 3. the Spirit of counsel== The Holy Spirit to guide and direct us,
- 4. and might = Holy Spirit give us Fortitude & Courage,
- 5. the Spirit of knowledge = Spirit of Truth & Prophecy
- 6. and of the fear of the Lord = Comes from knowing God & who He is = which brings forth the Spirit of "Love, Allegiance and Obedience"
- 3 And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the Lord; and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears;
- 7. But with righteousness = Piety/Holiness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth;



Joseph taught that knowing the attributes of God did away with doubt


and made one's faith exceedingly strong.

Could men exercise faith in God without an acquaintance with his attributes...They could not."

Coming to Know Christ Anchors Your Faith
